Your Phone

- (1) Handset
- (2) Base Station
- (3) Charger Cradle
- (4) Battery level indicator
- (5) Soft Key
- (6) On/Off Button
- (7) Lock/Unlock
- (8) Mute
- (9) Navigation Button

Basic Operations

Turning Handset On/Off:

- Press , then the LCD screen lights up.
- Place the Handset in the charger cradle to turn on automatically.
- Long press 🕤 again to turn the Handset off.

Locking/Unlocking keypad:

- Long press ## when the Handset is idle to lock the keypad.
- Long press # again to unlock the keypad.

Switching Silent Mode On/Off:

- Long press 👪 when the Handset is idle to lock the keypad.
- Long press 🕶 again to unlock the keypad.

Make a Call

Enter the desired number when the handset, then press .

To place a call from the local directory:

- 1. Press ▼ when the handset is idle.
- 2. Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight the desired entry, and then then press / .

Answer a Call, do one of the following:

- Press the **Accept** soft key.
- Alternatively press **II** , **C** or **©** .

To end a Call

Press 🙃 .

Put a Call on Hold

- 1. Press the **Options** soft key during a call, and then select Hold.
- 2. To resume the call, press the **Resume** soft key.

Access the Directory

- Press the key to enter the main menu, and then select **Directory** OR
- When the Handset is idle press ∇ .

Transfer a Call to Another Person

- Press the **Options** soft key during call, and then select Transfer.
- 2. Enter the number you want to transfers the call to.
- 3. Press **Transfer** soft key.

Make a Call with the Speakerphone

- 1. Enter a number using the keypad.
- 2. Press Speakerphone . .

Mute Your Audio

- 1. Press Mute key.
- 2. Press **Mute** again to turn mute off.

Listen to Your Voice Messages

Press **Messages** keys and follow the voice prompts. To check messages for a specific line, press the line button first.

Adjust the Volume in a Call

Whilst in call, press ◀ or ▶ .

Adjust the Ringtone Volume

Press ◀ or ▶ , whilst in a call.
